

Chapel Project (Final Phase)


So far, we have been able to complete the first two phases debt-free from the generous donations of Hartstone supporters. How soon we can begin the final phase depends on the Lord's provision. We estimate the cost to be around \$250,000. Part of this cost includes an electrical power upgrade for the camp to add power to the addition of the chapel and to power the HVAC system. This will also allow us to upgrade the power supply to our RV sites which are currently under powered.

Phase 3 of the Chapel Project will be an addition to the front of the chapel where we will put in new ADA restrooms and a lobby area. This lobby area will include a fireplace and comfortable seating. We will also have a display wall showing the history of the Hartstone ministry. This will be accompanied by a beautiful covered porch entrance. Finally, we will install an HVAC system for the sanctuary and lobby. Please pray that the Lord would provide the final funds to

complete this project. We believe that His provision thus far is evidence that not only does our Lord deserve worship, but He highly desires it! We are so excited to be able to bless our brothers and sisters in Christ who visit Hartstone with a beautiful new place to hear from His Word, pray, and worship in song! Please prayerfully consider how you could partner with us.
